

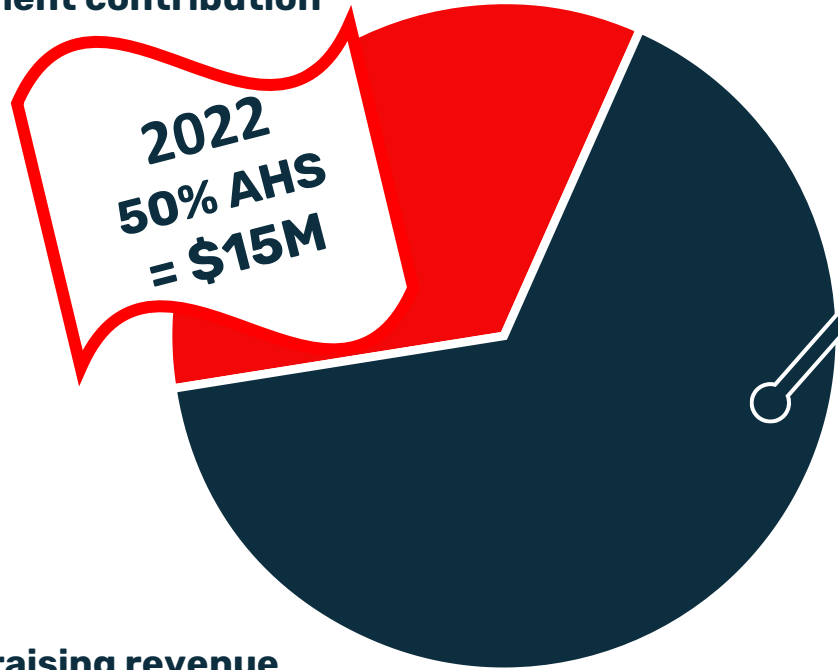

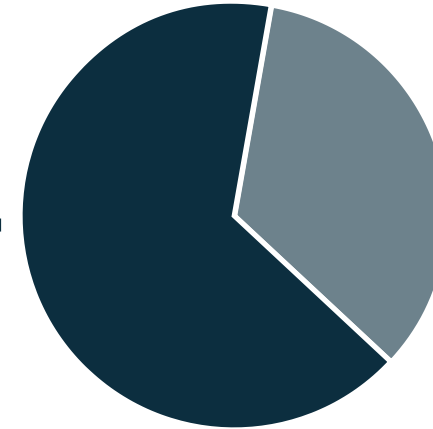


# STARS ALBERTA REVENUE FISCAL 2023

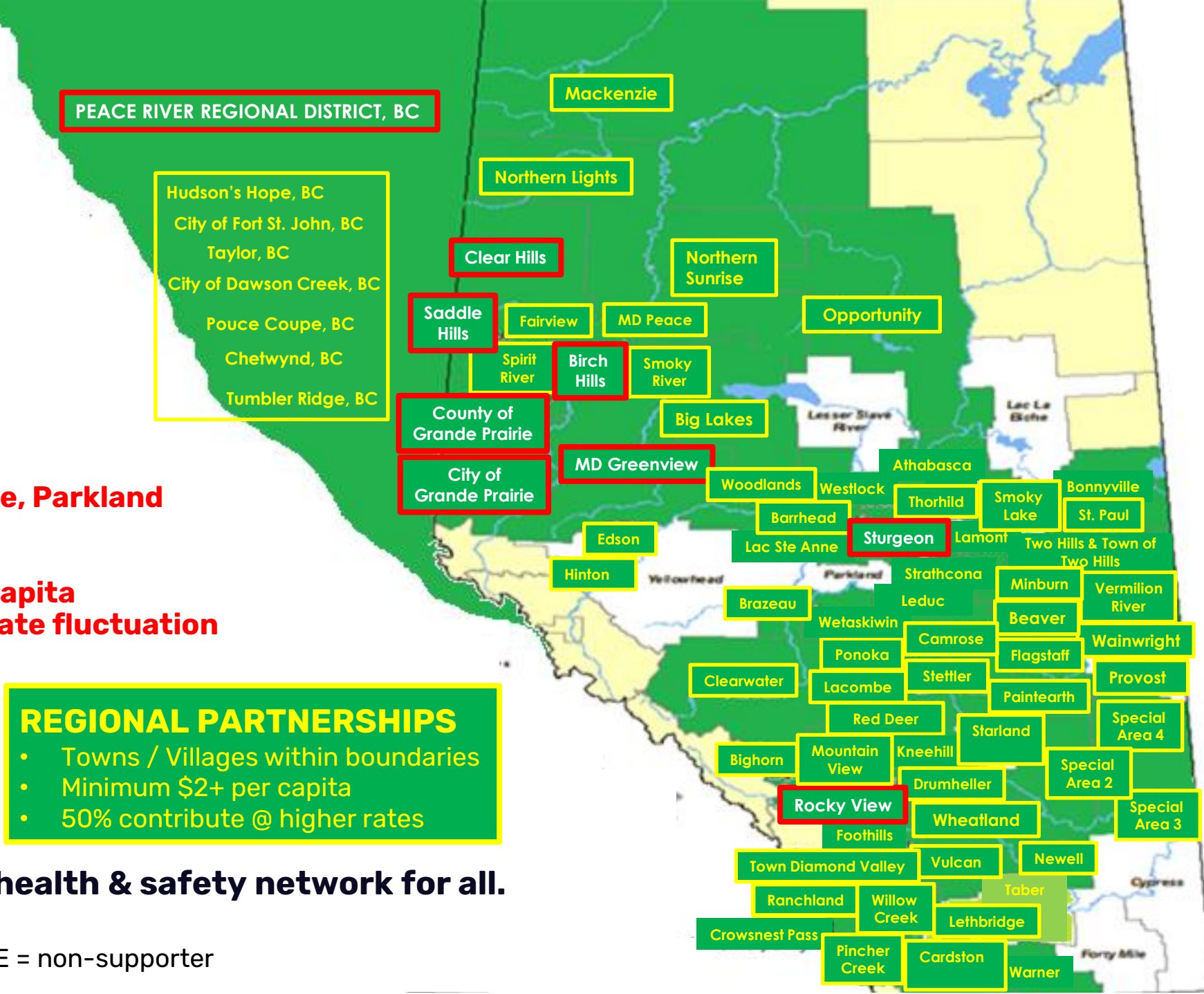

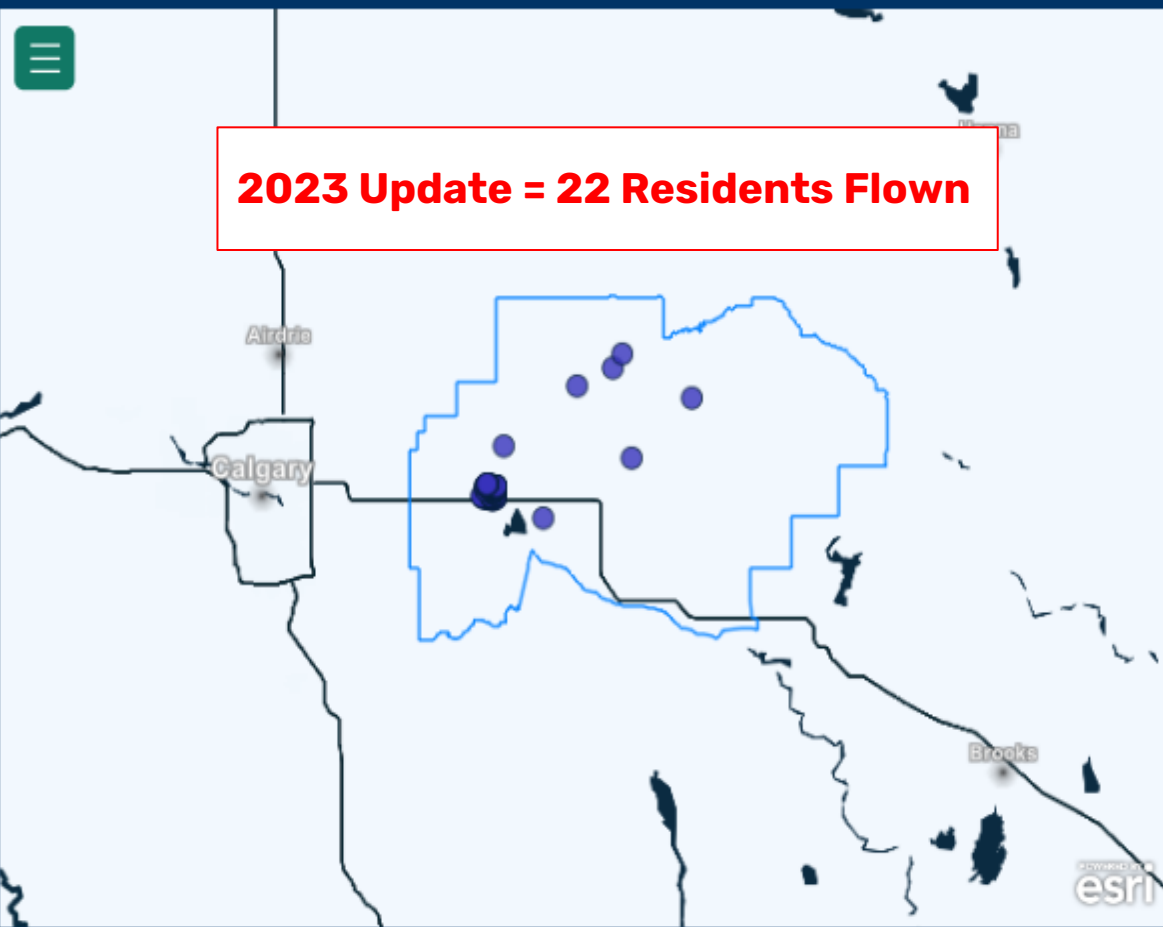

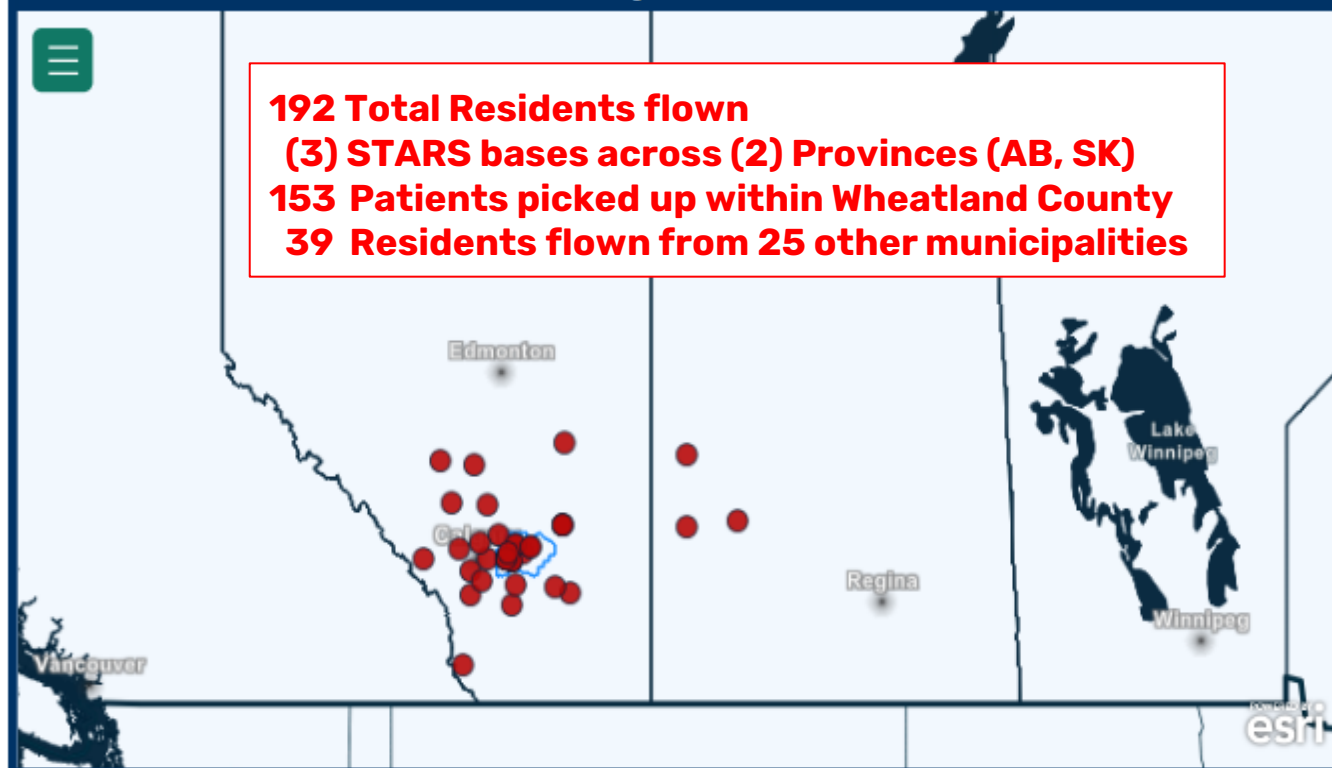

# Within Wheatland County Boundaries - Patients Flown by STARS (2010-Present)

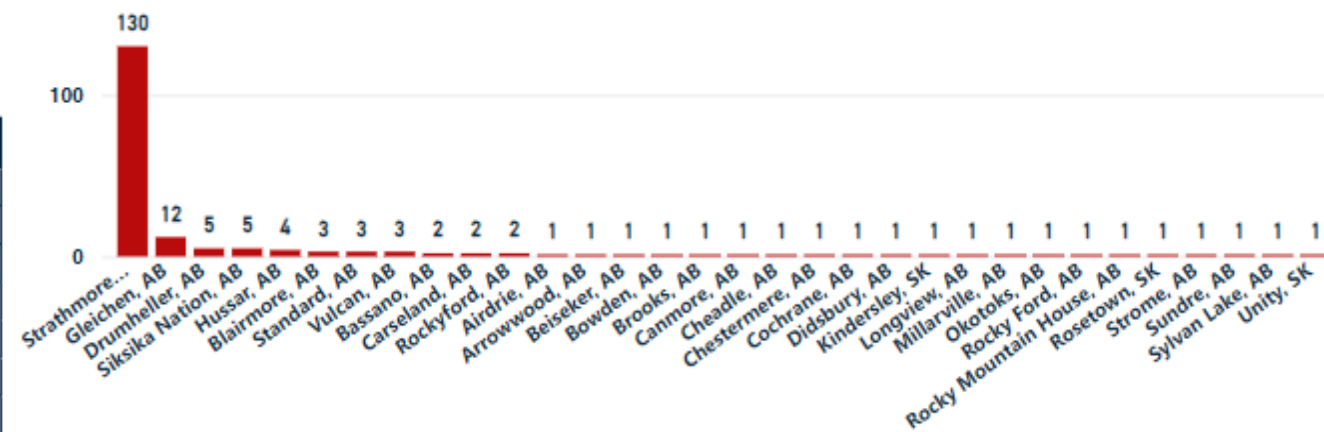
## Wheatland County Residents Flown by STARS
